QUALIFICATION OVERVIEW

CPC33020 Certificate III in Bricklaying and Blocklaying is a nationally recognised vocational qualification providing the practical skills and theoretical knowledge required to work as a bricklayer across residential and commercial construction. The course covers handling and laying bricklaying and blocklaying materials, masonry veneer and cavity brick construction, laying masonry walls and corners, and constructing masonry features such as arches and curved walls.







What a bricklayer does

Bricklayers interpret plans and specifications, set out and lay masonry walls, corners, piers and structural systems, install flashings and damp proof course, construct masonry arches, curved walls and other decorative features, and apply safe work practices on construction sites.
