CPC31020 Certificate III in Solid Plastering is a nationally recognised vocational qualification providing the practical skills and theoretical knowledge required to work as a solid plasterer across residential and commercial construction. The course covers handling solid plastering materials, preparing surfaces, applying float and render, set coats and trowelled texture finishes, and restoring and renovating solid plasterwork.

Solid plasterers prepare surfaces, apply float and render to straight and curved surfaces, apply set coats and trowelled texture finishes, restore and renovate solid plasterwork, and apply safe work practices on construction sites.
